GENERAL PRINCIPLES ADAPTATION OF NATIONAL LEGISLATION ON ISSUES OF EDUCATION, TRAINING AND RETRAINING OF CIVIL SERVANTS ACCORDING TO EU NORMS

The article is devoted to outlining and summary analysis of the general principles of adaptation of national legislation on training, retraining and advanced training of civil servants in the EU. In particular, the author determined the list of relevant principles (including the rule of law, democracy, humanism, openness, etc.) and revealed their contents.

It should be underlined that the nature, content and purpose of mentioned guidelines are really decisive, fundamental to the nature of the process of adaptation of national legislation on the training of civil servants for EU legislation to determine their general ideas as fundamental, guiding principles that define the priorities for its realization.

On the basis of the outlined principles adaptation of national legislation on issues of training, retraining and advanced training of civil servants with EU regulations and their analysis can be defined as the last basic principles, assumptions, characterized by versatility, overall significance, higher imperative and reflective material aspects and vectors Approximation of the training of EU law. And these principles are advisable to be classified according to their purpose into general and special. However, the general principles of adaptation of national legislation on training, retraining and advanced training of civil servants with EU regulations, in our view, should include the following: the rule of law; rule of law; principle regard to the situation of Ukrainian society; principle of science; principle of humanity; principle of democracy; the principle of transparency, the principle of consistency.
